## 1. <u>Delhi Administration</u>, <u>Directorate of Social Welfare</u>, <u>Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi</u>

With the financial assistance from Delhi Admin., and sundry donations from charitable institutions like Sitaram Jindal Foundation, Shree Sai Sansthan, Rotary Club, Lion's Club, Lal Dwara Mandir and individuals, running of the following Destitute Homes has been continued by BAJSS during the year 2012-13 for protection and care of children in need as per the prescribed norms.

# A) Matru Chhaya Bal Sadan at Rajendra Ashram, (Pandav Nagar), Delhi for boys in need of care and protection

Matru Chhaya Bal Sadan was opened in 1979-90 initially for 50 orphan boys and later increased the strength of inmates upto 100 boys. As per Conditions and financial assistance by the Directorate of Social Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, under juvenile Act, Matru Chhaya Bal Sadan run by BAJSS, New Delhi during in year 2012-13. Most of the boys belong to backward and

financially weak communities. They are taught in the nearby schools upto Class Xth and given coaching by qualified trained teachers. They are given training of computer courses with the meager resources of the Ashram and donors. National functions and important festivals are celebrated with participation of interested locals. On inspection andrecommendation of government officials grant in aid is sanctioned on year to year basis.

## B) Katyayani Nirashrit Balika Ashram for 75 destitute girls at the BAJSS Head Office

The ashram was started on 27.12.1990 From the year 2012-13 the Katyayani Nirashrit Balika Ashram is run under Juvenile Act. All the girls are staying in the Ashram and educated in nearly Schools. They live with carefree mind and smile on their face. These girls are very lucky as donors are taking interest in meeting their requirement to the extent possible. National functions and important festivals are celebrated in participation of interested locals. On the inspection and recommendations of government officials, grant-in-aid is sanctioned on yearly basis.

#### 2. Assam:

With the assistance from the District authorities one Training

Centre for weaving and pattern making is being run for 25 inmates at Kokrajhar.

### 3. Arunachal Pradesh, Directorate of Social Welfare:

Hostel and Destitute Homes: With the assistance from the State Govt. one Destitute Home for 25 tribal children are being run at Rupa, Arunachal Pradesh.

### 4. Nagaland, Directorate of Social Welfare: Nagaland Gandhi Ashram

Located at Chuchuyimlong is doing welfare work in Nagaland with assistance from the Khadi Commission. The Ashram is imparting training to Naga tribals in weaving and carpentry.

- 5. **Manipur**, Directorate of Tribal Welfare: Vocational Training (Tailoring & Wool Knitting) is being run by Adimjati Shiksha Ashram, Imphal smoothly with financial assistance from Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Manipur State.
- 6. **College Education**: Affiliated institutions at Rajur and Nasik (Maharashtra) and at Dharwad (Karnataka) are running colleges primarily for SC/ST/OBC students.
